Planning and Zoning:

1. Council action on public hearings.

A. Request to rezone property from MHD – Medium & High Density Residential to LD – Low Density Residential. Applicant: City of Long Beach. Sec/Twp/Range: 10-125-38. Green Valley Resort (GRV) Impervious Study Results. Fred Sandal gave a report on the study findings to the council. GRV is currently within the allowed impervious surface. - 3. **Update on 6" Line cover near Brownies HWY 28/29.** Permits have been issued and the lowering of the 6 inch main will begin the week of the 16th and should finish up within one week of the start date.
- 4. Pope County Solid Waste. Christa Weitzel presented the city information on the benefits of an organics waste drop site. Pope/Douglas Solid Waste has approved and will pay for the site. The service will be free of charge to the city and residents of Long Beach. City will discuss further at the next council meeting and follow up with Christa.
